### FABLEIST WINE COMPANY

373 Cabernet Sauvignon – Paso Robles.

California 2019 \$10/\$44

Sumptuous black fruit, a touch of oak, and soft tannins. Great New World Cab.

### GORDO RED BLEND

Yecla, Spain 2017 \$8/\$36

Boysenberry, blackberry, rosemary, smokey black pepper, cola, clove, and a dash of cedar. Pairs perfectly with our charcuterie.

### ZORZAL PINOT NOIR

Mendoza Argentina 2018 \$7/\$34

Cherry, raspberry, and strawberry with nice hit of spice. (And YAY, it tastes like Pinot and not Syrah.)

### BODEGA BOUZA TANNAT RESERVA

Montevideo, Uruguay 2018 \$10/\$48

Rich and intense, fresh and bold, very expressive on the nose. Many consider Tannat as the ultimate wine with red meat.

### VELENOSI LACRIMA DI MORRO D'ALBA

Marche, Italy 2019 \$8/\$36

Ancient, (and nearly extinct till the 80's), this teardrop grape produces an incredibly aromatic wine that is unlike any other. Bright red fruit that gives way to an almost baking spice like aroma and explodes with cherry, strawberry, and violet on the palate.

California \$9/\$40

Deep, dark, rich, black cherry, plum, blueberry, and dark chocolate, with a touch of vanilla and oak.

## SPARKLING

### CANTINA DEL GARDA PROSECCO DOC

Veneto, Italy \$8/\$36

Beautiful bubbles with yellow apples, stone fruit, wildflowers and fresh-cut honeydew.

Veneto, Italy \$8/\$36

Strawberry, red plum, wild flowers and lively acid...if you've not had any rosé Prosecco, do yourself a favor...

## WHITE WINE

### MORGAN WINERY CHARDONNAY

Santa Lucia Highlands, California 2018 \$9/\$38

Opulent pear, peach, white plum and toasty oak. Perfect balance of richness and acidity.

### MAX FERD RICHTER "ZEPPELIN" RIESLING

Mosel, Germany 2020 \$7/\$30

This off-dry Riesling has loads of green apple, grapefruit, lime, a touch of minerality, and zesty herbs. This is off dry, NOT sticky sweet. It is ridiculously drinkable.

### PAVETTE SAUVIGNON BLANC

Walla Walla, Washington 2019 \$7/\$30

Notes of grapefruit, lemon, lime, tropical fruit, and a touch of thyme. Super crushable.

### DOMAINE MICHEL BARRAUD MÂCON-VILLAGES

Burgundy, France 2019 \$8/\$35

Minimal intervention chardonnay from very old vines without the crazy price tag. Super bright and crisp with beautiful apple, pear, quince, and spice.

### SASSOREGALE VERMENTINO

Maremma, Toscana, Italy 2020 \$7/\$30

Citrus and stone fruits, wild herbs and flowers, a touch of almond and zippy tang. What's not to love?

### LECTHALER PINOT GRIGIO

Trentino, Alto Adige, Italy 2019 \$7/\$28

Light bodied and refreshingly floral, with green apple, blood orange and ginger.

### SAUSKA ROSE

Villány, Hungary 2019 \$7/\$30

Beautifully balanced and refreshing, with lemon, gooseberry, pomegranate, and lush melon.

## CIDER

### SHACKSBURY CIDER "DRY"

Vergennes, VT – 5.5% – \$6

The gold standard for a classic dry cider. Dry is a shape-shifter — equally at home at an upscale meal as it is in your cooler. The secret to its success is slow, cool fermentation and the blend of apples: Cider-specific varieties make for a dry, refreshing and complex cider. Dry has no added sugar & is gluten free.
